Virtual Family Walkathon 2020

“Your Walkathon Your Way”

Dear Parents & Students,

This year’s walkathon will look a little different due to the current pandemic. As we deal with our current situation, we have had to cancel ALL school fundraisers except our Walkathon. This is because the Walkathon will be done outside of school property on your own or with your friends or family. This year’s Virtual Family Walkathon “*Your Walkathon Your Way*” will take place on the weekend of October 16. Students and their families will have 3 days to participate in this year’s walkathon with Friday, October 16, as a day off to kick start your virtual walk.

In the past, this fundraiser has been very successful in helping us raise funds for projects outside our normal budget. Our goal is to raise \$40,000 this year. In previous years the funds have gone towards helping the school purchase; a 3D printer, outdoor basketball hoops, concrete ping pong tables, outdoor picnic tables, 2 water stations, hand dryers for the washrooms, bleachers for the sports fields, and two new school buses.

For this year we would like to try something new and have re-vamped our student prizes. Numerous prizes will be awarded to all students that contribute financially.

How will this work:

- Every student that donates (minimum \$50) will have their name added to the prize draw.
- For every additional \$25 you raise, your name will be added. (ie. If you raise \$75 your name will go into the draw twice)
- Our exciting list of prizes will be announced prior to October 16th. There will also be Family Prizes for Carney families that participate in the year’s Walkathon.

We are hoping that all families will use CHIMP, our easy on-line donation process. To donate please visit our website at acrss.org and click the “Donate” button. By using CHIMP families will receive their tax receipt promptly and automatically by email and our school will receive donations quickly and efficiently. Of course we will still accept cheque donations, but unfortunately NO CASH due to COVID.
